End of day procedures:

As the fair starts at 2pm, parent's are asked to collect their child early.

Between 1.55 and 2pm—children can be picked up as normal end of day procedure

Year 5 and 6 children **MUST** be collected and are not allowed to walk home alone before 3.15pm

From 2.05pm till 3.15pm—Infant children to be collected from Reception Classroom

Junior children to be collected from Year 4 classroom (through the main entrance as access will not be permitted through the side door)

All infant children who are still here at 3.15pm will need to be collected promptly from Reception class.

All junior children still here at 3.15pm will need to be collected from the Year 3/4 side door. Year 5 and 6 children may walk home if school already hold permission for them to do so.

The fair finishes at 4.00pm prompt.
