Dear Parents and Carers,

We will be having a special 'Book Week' at St Joseph's from 4th March-8th March. The children will be taking part in a range of exciting activities throughout the week to foster reading for pleasure. As in previous years, we will be having a 'Come as a Book Character' fancy dress competition and a 'Book in a Box' competition.



The children should choose a box (any size) and re-create a scene from their chosen book inside it. You can use any materials, eggs, paint, paper, Lego etc. to decorate it- the more creative the better! Please label the entry with your child's name, class and the book the box is based on.

Children should come into school dressed as their favourite book character on Thursday 7th March. They should bring their 'Book in a Box' entries into school on the Thursday. All entries must be placed on the class table in the hall by 9AM- ready for judging.

There will be a special World Book Day Assembly at 9.30 on this day -Thursday March 7th- to which all parents and family members are warmly welcome.

BOOK QUIZ COMPETITION

To raise money for the school, the PTFA have created two book quizzes (one for EYFS/ KS1 and one for KS2). The person who gets the most questions correct will win a fantastic prize. There will be one winner per class.

The quiz costs 50p and can be collected from your child's class teacher.
