Car Parking

Can I remind all parents to be considerate of our neighbours when parking outside of school. Parking on yellow zig zags and keep clear boxes is illegal. Parking enforcement officers from Lancashire County Council regularly monitor vehicle parking. This is for the safety of our children at drop off and pick up time.

Can I also request that parents do not park on property that does not belong to the school or highways. We have been asked by Dacrelands Clinic to remind parents that their car park is private and for the use of their clients only. There has been an occasion where the entrance to the car park has been blocked.

According to Highway Code Rule 243, you should not park near a school entrance — as well as anywhere that would prevent access for emergency services, at or near a bus stop, opposite or within 10 metres of a junction, over a dropped kerb, and in front of an entrance to a property.

Please can we all be mindful of this.
