Bug Busting

We have had several cases of headlice in school recently. Please check your child's hair tonight and if you find live headlice start the treatment. Remember you have to treat the whole family and wash the bedding and towels. You must follow the instructions on the package and you may have to re-apply again. Use conditioner and a fine tooth comb to comb through hair in between treatments.

Check your child's hair on a regular basis and using conditioner and a fine tooth comb will help to keep the headlice at bay.
