

## COMPUTING

### Online Safety

The children will discuss and understand the importance of keeping personal information safe. To understand issues concerning the reliability of sources and people online.

## RE

Year 5 will be exploring inspirational communities, inspirational people and their spiritual missions. They will be making links to Jesus' mission and beginning to think about their own mission.

## ENGLISH

In English we will be reading our class novel "Cosmic" by Frank Cottrell Boyce. We will be exploring the thoughts and feelings of the characters and well as writing in a variety of different ways to express our understanding.



## MATHS

In Maths we will be revising multiplication and division with a focus on formal methods.



## SCIENCE

Science this half term sees us studying and researching Earth and Space. We will be looking at spherical bodies and the evidence gathered to support this. We will be observing how Earth's rotation influences day and night and its orbit of the sun affects our years. Finally we will be exploring the different phases of the moon.

## ART

In art we will be looking at our drawing and painting skills. The children will work from a variety of sources whilst exploring both wet and dry media to make different marks, lines, patterns and textures. They will develop a painting from a drawing whilst creating imaginative work. They will mix and match colours to create atmosphere and light effects.

## PSHE

Linking with our theme Earthlings we will be looking at our emotional health and well-being; thinking about how we manage feelings such as stress and anger. We will do this by observing: managing our feelings, compassion and empathy, life experiences, self-esteem and confidence, looking at the future, being happy and being mindful.

## PE

This half term we will be learning the basic skills needed for Hi 5 netball.

## MUSIC

The children will sing songs; speak chants and rhymes in unison and two parts. They will listen with attention to a range of high quality music. They will improvise and develop rhythmic melodies to perform.
